NOTE: VWF activity may be increased above baseline levels by acute or chronic inflammation, stress or adrenergic stimuli, pregnancy or estrogen and oral contraceptive (OCP) therapy, liver disease or recent infusion of plasma, cryoprecipitate, desmopressin (DDAVP) or VWF concentrates and mask the diagnosis of mild von Willebrand disease (VWD). Note: Apparently normal individuals of blood group "O" may have somewhat lower von Willebrand factor (VWF) than individuals of other blood groups, such that (for example) those of group "O" may have VWF as low as 40–50%, whereas normals of nongroup "O" generally have VWF above 60–70%. Suggest clinical correlation.
