Peripheral Blood, chimerism analysis:

The specimen contains approximately 90% donor DNA and approximately 10% recipient DNA.

3 informative loci were used in the analysis of this sample.

The analytical sensitivity of this assay is approximately 5% in a posttransplant specimen (donor and recipient DNA mixed chimerism).

Method summary - Chimerism: Genomic DNA was extracted and the specimen evaluated for the percentages of donor and recipient DNA using a PCR-based method that amplifies several highly polymorphic short tandem repeats (see Mayo Clinic Laboratories Interpretive Handbook for method details).
