CEA, Pancreatic Cyst

A pancreatic cyst fluid CEA concentration of ≥ 200 ng/mL is very suggestive but not diagnostic of a mucinous cyst (Khalid A, and Brugge W, Amer. J. Gastroenterol. 102:2339-49;2007). Cyst fluid CEA concentrations of ≤ 5 ng/mL indicate a low risk for a mucinous cyst, and are more consistent with serous cystadenoma, fluid collections complicating pancreatitis, cystic neuroendocrine tumor, or metastatic lesions. CEA values between these extremes have limited diagnostic value. This clinical interpretation is only applicable to cyst fluid. For pancreatic sources other than cyst fluid clinical interpretation is not available. This test result should be interpreted in the context of clinical presentation, imaging and cytology findings.

The testing method is an immunoenzymatic assay manufactured by Beckman Coulter Inc. and performed on the UniCel DxI 800.

Values obtained with different assay methods or kits may be different and cannot be used interchangeably.

Test results cannot be interpreted as absolute evidence for the presence or absence of malignant disease.
