A pleural fluid total protein to serum total protein ratio >0.5 is most consistent with exudative effusion. A peritoneal fluid total protein > 2.5 g/dL in patients with a high serum ascites albumin gradient can be caused by heart failure. A peritoneal fluid total protein > 1.0 g/dL helps to differentiate secondary from spontaneous bacterial peritonitis in conjunction with other laboratory, imaging, and clinical findings.
