IMPRESSION: Positive. Assays confirm the presence of a specific inhibitor of factor IX (FIX).

COMMENTS: Decreased factor IX coagulant activity. Result of qualitative FIX inhibitor screening assay is consistent with and titrating assay (Bethesda), performed after pre-analytic heat inactivation of patient plasma, confirms the presence of a specific inhibitor of coagulation factor IX. The Bethesda titer is 0.6 Bethesda Units.
