

Reporting Title: Bilirubin, BF
Performing Location: Rochester

Ordering Guidance:
For bilirubin testing on urine specimens, order BILUR / Bilirubin, Random, Urine. Testing will be changed to UBILU if this test is ordered on urine specimens.

Shipping Instructions:
Ship specimen in amber vial to protect from light.

- Necessary Information:
- 1. Date and time of collection are required.
 - 2. Specimen source is required.

Specimen Requirements:

Supplies: Amber Frosted Tube, 5 mL (T915)

Preferred Source:

- Peritoneal fluid (peritoneal, abdominal, ascites, paracentesis)
- Pleural fluid (pleural, chest, thoracentesis)
- Drain fluid (drainage, Jackson Pratt [JP] drain)
- Pericardial fluid

Acceptable Source: Write in source name with source location (if appropriate)

Collection Container/Tube: Sterile container

Submission Container/Tube: Opaque, amber vial

Specimen Volume: 1 mL

Collection Instructions:

- 1. Centrifuge to remove any cellular material and transfer into an amber vial to protect from light.
- 2. Indicate the specimen source and source location on label.
