

Reporting Title: Triglycerides, BF

Ordering Guidance:

For help distinguishing between chylous and nonchylous effusions, order BFLA1 / Lipid Analysis, Body Fluid. The body fluid will be tested for cholesterol and triglyceride concentrations and undergo lipoprotein electrophoresis.

- Necessary Information:**
- 1. Date and time of collection is required.
 - 2. Specimen source is required.

Specimen Requirements:

Preferred Source:

- Peritoneal fluid (peritoneal, abdominal, ascites, paracentesis)
- Pleural fluid (pleural, chest, thoracentesis)
- Drain fluid (drainage, JP drain)
- Pericardial Fluid

Acceptable Source: Write in source name with source location (if appropriate)

Collection Container/Tube: Sterile container

Submission Container/Tube: Plastic vial

Specimen Volume: 1 mL

Collection Instructions:

- 1. Centrifuge to remove any cellular material and transfer into a plastic vial.
- 2. Indicate the specimen source and source location on label.
