

Test Definition: HBCPR

Hepatitis B Virus Core Total Antibodies Prenatal, Serum

Reporting Title: HBc Total Ab Prenatal, S **Performing Location:** Rochester

Ordering Guidance:

This test should **not** be used to test **symptomatic** individuals (ie, diagnostic purposes) suspected with viral hepatitis. For testing such patients with or without risk factors for hepatitis B virus (HBV) infection, order HBC / Hepatitis B Virus Core Total Antibodies, Serum.

This test should **not** be used to screen or test **asymptomatic**, **nonpregnant** individuals with or without risk factors for HBV infection. For testing such patients, order HBCSN / Hepatitis B Virus Core Total Antibodies Screen, Serum.

If hepatitis B core total antibody test that reflexes to hepatitis B virus core IgM, order CORAB / Hepatitis B Virus Core Total Antibodies, with Reflex to Hepatitis B Virus Core Antibody IgM, Serum.

Necessary Information:

Date of collection is required.

Specimen Requirements:

Patient Preparation: For 24 hours before specimen collection, patient should not take multivitamins or dietary supplements (eg, hair, skin, and nail supplements) containing biotin (vitamin B7). Supplies: Sarstedt Aliquot Tube, 5 mL (T914) Collection Container/Tube: Serum gel Submission Container/Tube: Plastic vial Specimen Volume: 0.7 mL Collection Instructions: 1. Centrifuge blood collection tube per manufacturer's instructions (eg, centrifuge and aliquot within 2 hours of collection for BD Vacutainer tubes).

2. Aliquot serum into a plastic vial.
