

# **Test Definition: MUMPU**

Mumps Virus, Molecular Detection, PCR, Urine

Reporting Title: Mumps Virus PCR, Urine

Performing Location: Rochester

## **Ordering Guidance:**

Polymerase chain reaction testing (this test) is recommended as the first-line test if a patient has symptoms of mumps (ie, fever, swollen salivary/parotid glands).

If serology has been performed and IgM-class antibodies against mumps are detected (MMPGM / <u>Mumps Virus</u> <u>Antibody, IgM and IgG, Serum</u>), this test should be ordered to confirm mumps infection.

## **Shipping Instructions:**

Specimens must be shipped at refrigerated temperature. Specimens received frozen will be rejected.

## **Specimen Requirements:**

**Supplies:** Urine Tubes, 10 mL (T068) **Container/Tube:** Plastic, 10-mL urine tube

**Specimen Volume:** 1 mL **Collection Instructions:** 

1. Collect a random urine specimen.

2. No preservative.
