Ordering Guidance:

Patients with a history of symptoms for more than 1 week may be negative by molecular tests (ie, real-time polymerase chain reaction) and may require serologic testing, which is available through the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Supplies: Sarstedt Aliquot Tube 5 mL (T914) Collection Container/Tube: Preferred: Serum gel Acceptable: Red top Submission Container: Plastic vial Specimen Volume: 0.5 mL

Collection Instructions:

- 1. Centrifuge blood collection tube and aliquot serum into a plastic vial within 2 hours of collection.
- 2. Label specimen as serum
