Reporting Title: Molybdenum, B **Performing Location:** Rochester

Specimen Requirements:

Patient Preparation: High concentrations of gadolinium and iodine are known to interfere with most metal tests. If either gadolinium- or iodine-containing contrast media has been administered, a specimen should not be collected for 96 hours.

Collection Container/Tube:

Preferred: Royal blue top (EDTA) plastic trace element blood collection tube

Specimen Volume: 0.8 mL **Collection Instructions:**

- 1. See Metals Analysis Specimen Collection and Transport for complete instructions.
- 2. Send whole blood specimen in original tube. Do not aliquot.
