## **Necessary Information:**

Indicate patient's age and sex

### **Specimen Requirements:**

**Collection Container/Tube:** 

**Preferred:** Serum gel **Acceptable:** Red top

Submission Container/Tube: Plastic vial

**Specimen Volume:** 0.5 mL **Collection Instructions:** 

- 1. Serum gel tube should be centrifuged within 2 hours of collection.
- 2. Red-top tube should be centrifuged, and the serum aliquoted into a plastic vial within 2 hours of collection.
