

## **Test Definition: EPIP1**

Epithelia Panel # 1, Serum

Reporting Title: Epithelia Panel # 1

Performing Location: Rochester

## Ordering Guidance:

This test uses a pooled allergen reagent; therefore, the multi-allergen Immunocap (panel cap) is reported with a single qualitative class result and concentration. This is the appropriate first-tier test for allergic disease.

## **Specimen Requirements:**

Collection Container/Tube: Preferred: Serum gel Acceptable: Red top

Submission Container/Tube: Plastic vial

Specimen Volume: 0.5 mL for every 5 allergens requested

Collection Instructions: Centrifuge and aliquot serum into a plastic vial.

## **Specimen Minimum Volume:**

0.3 mL
