

Test Definition: PBU

Lead, 24 Hour, Urine

Reporting Title: Lead, 24 Hr, U **Performing Location:** Rochester

Ordering Guidance:

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends venous blood collection for lead testing; see PBDV / Lead, Venous, with Demographics, Blood

Necessary Information:

24-Hour volume (in milliliters) is required.

Specimen Requirements:

Patient Preparation: High concentrations of gadolinium and iodine are known to interfere with most metal tests. If either gadolinium- or iodine-containing contrast media has been administered, a specimen should not be collected for 96 hours.

Supplies: Urine Tubes, 10 mL (T068)

Collection Container/Tube: Clean, plastic urine container with no metal cap or glued insert

Submission Container/Tube: Plastic, 10-mL urine tube or a clean, plastic aliquot container with no metal cap or glued

insert

Specimen Volume: 10 mL Collection Instructions:

- 1. Collect urine for 24 hours.
- 2. Refrigerate specimen within 4 hours of completion of 24-hour collection.
- 3. See Metals Analysis Specimen Collection and Transport for complete instructions.

Additional Information: See Urine Preservatives-Collection and Transportation for 24-Hour Urine Specimens for multiple collections.

Specimen Minimum Volume:

2 mL

Note: The addition of preservative or application of temperature controls must occur within 4 hours of completion of the collection.
