Streptococcus pneumoniae Antigen, Spinal Fluid

Reporting Title: Streptococcus pneumoniae Ag, CSF

Performing Location: Rochester

Additional Testing Requirements:

According to the College of American Pathologists (CAP, IMM.41830), cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) samples collected to make an initial diagnosis and submitted for detection of Streptococcus pneumoniae antigen testing should also be submitted for routine bacterial culture. Mayo Clinic Laboratories recommends that CSF bacterial cultures be performed at the originating site.

Specimen Requirements:

Container/Tube: Sterile vial Specimen Volume: 1 mL

Collection Instructions: Submit specimen collected in vial 2, if possible. If not possible, note which vial from which the

aliquot was obtained.

Specimen Minimum Volume:

0.5 mL
