Specimen Type: Plasma (Preferred) Container/Tube: Green-top (sodium heparin) tube(s). Specimen volume: 3 mL Collection Instructions: Draw blood in a green-top (sodium heparin) tube(s), plasma gel tube is not acceptable. Spin down and send 3 mL sodium heparin plasma refrigerated in a plastic vial.

Serum

Specimen Type: Serum Container/Tube: Red-top tube, serum gel is not acceptable. Specimen volume: 3 mL Collection Instructions: Draw blood in a plain red-top tube(s), serum gel tube is not acceptable. Spin down and send 3 mL of serum refrigerated in a plastic vial.
